

MINUTES – Board of Canvassers

Port Washington-Saukville School District

April 12, 2021

School Board Secretary Heidi Belohlav called the meeting of the Board of Canvassers for the Port Washington-Saukville School District Board of Education to order at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, April 12, 2021, in the District Office Conference Room, 100 W. Monroe Street, Port Washington.

PRESENT: JoAnne Jacobson, Kelly O’Connell-Perket, and Brooke Uhlig made up the Board of Canvassers. Heidi Belohlav (Board Secretary/Deputy School Board Clerk) was present to take minutes and prepare necessary paperwork for signature.

It was noted that the meeting notice was posted to the public at the Port Washington City Hall, the Saukville Village Hall, and by providing copies to the Ozaukee Press-Port Publications and the town board chairs, and was posted on the main entrance doors of each building in the school district.

Spring election information received from each municipality was reviewed and checked for accuracy.

For the two (2) City of Port Washington apportioned School Board seats, Danielle Mayer received the highest number of votes; Brenda Fritch received the second highest number of votes; Robert Brooks received the third highest number of votes; and Aaron Paulin received the lowest number of votes.

For the one (1) Village of Saukville apportioned School Board seat, Douglas Mueller ran unopposed.

The Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers was prepared. Upon noting that all numbers were correct, members of the Board of Canvassers signed their Certificate attesting to that fact. Danielle Mayer, Brenda Fritsch, and Douglas Mueller were each elected to a three-year term on the Port Washington-Saukville Board of Education.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Canvassers, the meeting adjourned at 4:37 p.m.
