**II. REVIEW SPONSORSHIP RECOGNITION FOR POSSIBLE DONATION TO THE PWSSD FOUNDATION**

J. Froemming and T. Ross, on behalf of the PWSSD Foundation, presented a request from Port Washington State Bank for a \$100,000 donation in return for sponsorship/naming rights of the Port Washington High School upper deck/commons area. A rendering of proposed signage and a plaque was also reviewed. J. Froemming provided information on the numerous donations that the bank has made over many decades in their ongoing support of the students in the District, including providing two annual scholarships to graduating seniors since 1949. J. Froemming reviewed information in Board Policy 9750 – (Naming Rights and Sponsorship Opportunities), and noted that the proposed donation meets all of the criteria outlined in Board policy for granting sponsorship/naming rights.

Klotz, moved to approve the sponsorship request and grant naming rights of the Port Washington High School Upper Deck commons area to the Port Washington State Bank as presented. Roll call vote: S. On behalf of the School Board, B. Fritsch thanked S. Schowalter and J. Schowalter for Port Washington State Bank’s generous donation, which will be used to support capital projects in the District.
