HOMEWORK

- I. The Board of Education acknowledges homework as extensions of the instructional program of the schools. The Board further recognizes the role of parents in providing assistance to their children.
- II. Homework shall refer to those assignments to be prepared outside of the school by the student or independently while in attendance at school.
- III. Homework should always serve a valid learning purpose.
- IV. When assigned:
 - A. Homework should be a planned part of the curriculum used to extend and reinforce the learning experience of the school.
 - B. The number, frequency, and degree of difficulty of homework assignments should be based on the ability and needs of the student.
 - C. Homework should be assigned with clear direction and its product carefully evaluated.
