USE OF TOBACCO BY PROFESSIONAL STAFF

- I. The Board of Education recognizes that the use of tobacco presents a health hazard, which can have serious consequences both for the user and the nonuser and is, therefore, of concern to the Board.
- II. For purposes of this policy, "use of tobacco" shall mean all uses of tobacco, including a cigar, cigarette, pipe, smokeless tobacco, or any other matter or substances that contain tobacco, including tobacco look-alike products and/or paraphernalia.
- III. State statutes prohibit the use of tobacco by professional staff members in District buildings, in District vehicles, on school grounds, and at District-related events, or where students are present.
