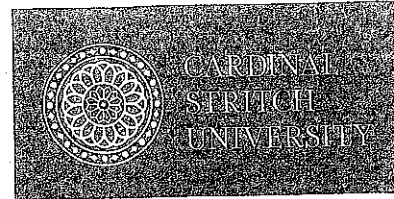

Summary

This discount is a tuition only discount for newly enrolled students in any COEL graduate level, degree seeking programs including Masters, Certificate, and Doctorate programs.
