Playground Rules and Regulations

(This same information is available as a PowerPoint presentation in the Dunwiddie Shared Staff Folder. Select the "Handbooks & More" folder and then select "Playground Rules and Regulations".)

1. The school will provide all playground equipment (balls, jump ropes, etc.) for students to use at recess times.
 - Playground equipment is for recess only! These items are not for before or after school.
 - One piece of equipment per student.
 - What equipment students take out, students must bring it back in!
 - Students are encourage to SHARE.



2. Bikes, skateboards and rollerblades are not permitted on the playground during school hours (8:10am to 3:45pm).
3. No aggressive physical contact will be permitted (i.e. pushing, kicking, pulling clothing or hair, tackling, fighting, etc.).



4. Throwing objects will not be permitted (i.e. woods chips, snowballs, hazardous objects, etc.)
5. Tag – This game may be played on the grass or blacktop only. It should not be played on the woodchip area or on playground structures.
6. Student Problem or Injury – Students need to find a playground supervisor to ask for help.
7. Rock Wall
 - Students are to climb up and down the Rock Wall, not over the top!!
 - One student per panel.

8. Whirly Twirly – No more than two students at a time (standing only – NO sitting).

9. Ladder
- Only one person per ladder.
 - One person sliding down the pole at a time.
10. Slides
- Students are to do down the slide in a forward sitting position (feet first).
 - One student at a time.
 - Students should move away from the slide before the next person slides down.
11. Swings
- One person is allowed on a swing at a time.
 - Students need to sit on the swing facing the school.
 - Students should remain outside the swing boundaries while waiting for a turn.
12. Playground Structures
- No standing on the top of the structure or climbing on the bars of the bridge.
 - Students should move across the swinging bridge quickly and safely.
 - No jumping on or off the bridge
13. Blacktop Activities (balls may not be kicked or thrown against the building)

14. Supervisor's Permission needed to:
- retrieve a ball if it leaves the playground.
 - enter the building to use the restroom.
 - enter the building to go to the office/health room.
15. Snow on the Playground – Students without boots or snow pants must stay on the blacktop or woodchip areas.
16. Directions given by playground supervisors must be followed at all times.

17. Line-Up Bell – Students need to lineup quickly and quietly at their designated entrance when the bell signals.
