Hello PWSSD Families,

We are excited to announce that through partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services and Summit Clinical Laboratories, COVID-19 testing will now be available at Port Washington High School.

The testing will be available to all PWSSD students, staff, and members of their same household Monday through Friday, 8:00am - 3:30pm. All individuals who get tested at this site will receive both a COVID-19 rapid antigen test and a COVID-19 PCR test completed at the same time. There is no cost for these tests.

In order for a student/minor to have a test completed at this site, we must have a signed consent form on file. You can access the consent form [here](#). Please complete this form and turn it in to your child's school office if you wish to have them eligible for testing at this location. We will also have a link to the consent form on the PWSSD webpage, <https://www.pwssd.k12.wi.us/>, and paper copies available at the testing site.
