## Purpose

## Student Responsibilities

- Pay a \$30 donation prior to the first meeting - **October 1**
- Attend three meetings

## Student Meetings – held during Resource in the Lower Cafeteria

- **October 1** - Organizational Meeting
- **November 18** - Presentation/Award Meeting
- **April 7** - Presentation/Award Meeting

## Presentation/Award Meetings

- Presentations by each applicant that was selected (5 minutes maximum)
- Students vote anonymously for the applicant to receive the donation.
- Mr. Gabrielse will call the recipient that was selected

## Application Process

- Each application must meet criteria for approval
  - Must benefit students or programs in the community
  - Maximum request amount is \$1500
- Three approved applications will be placed randomly drawn
- The three selections will be invited to the Presentation/Award Meeting to request support
- Applications not selected will be eligible for future selection

## **Application Deadlines**

- **Semester 1**
  - **November 6** - Application due
  - **November 9** - Three applications are drawn randomly for the presentation mtg
  - **November 26** - Three projects present at the student meeting and a recipient is selected
- **Semester 2**
  - **March 5** - Application due
  - **March 8** - Three applications are drawn randomly for the presentation mtg
  - **April 7** - Three projects present at the student meeting and a recipient is selected
