- Meeting One-October 13- During Resource-Organization Meeting
- Meeting Two-Fall Giving Meeting-November 17 during the resource period-Presentation/Award Meeting.
 - Students listen to 3 presentations (5 minutes max) and then vote anonymously for the project they would like to receive funds
 - Projects due by October 29 for consideration for Fall
 - November 1 -3 Projects drawn randomly for November 17 presentations
- Meeting Three-April 6- During the resource period-Presentation/Award Meeting
 - Students listen to 3 presentations (5 minutes max) and then vote anonymously for the project they would like to receive funds
 - Projects due by March 4 for consideration in Spring
 - March 7-3 Projects drawn randomly for April 6 presentations
- The donations (\$30 per year) will be deposited into a District fundraising account.
 - Students can make full \$30 donation at the beginning of the school year
 - We encourage students to use their own \$\$ for this project if possible
 - Students will make donation in the High School Office

- Port Washington-Saukville Rotary has pledged to match the total donation of the students.
- What will happen at each meeting
 - Guest speaker
 - Presentations by school groups (students/staff) selected to speak
 - School groups will submit requests for donations (up to \$1500)
 at least two weeks prior to each meeting.
 - Criteria for approval of request
 - Must benefit students or programs in the community
 - Maximum request amount \$1500
 - Approved requests will be placed in a bin and three requests (picked one week prior to the meeting) will be invited to the meeting to request support.
 - Students vote anonymously for the project to receive the donation for this meeting
 - Projects not selected will be placed back in the bin for future meetings
