ACADEMIC JUMPSTART COURSES

Jumpstart Courses are designed for students who may need a little extra help or practice in Math, Reading, and/or Writing. Jumpstart courses **DO NOT REQUIRE a Teacher's Recommendation**; however, a teacher may suggest as to which course your child may benefit from the most. We hope you will HIGHLY consider our teacher feedback and take advantage of this opportunity. The number of students in each of these classes is kept as low as possible to allow for as much teacher attention as possible and assure maximum individual growth.

➤ **MATH JUMPSTART, GRADES 1-8**

This course is designed to strengthen mathematical fundamentals and explore concepts and skills within the jumpstart model. Students will discover varied strategies to help broaden their mathematical understanding, make connections to standards, and promote self-confidence and perseverance.

➤ **A-Z ANIMALS TO ZOOS**
