

PWSSD ANNOUNCES FREE LUNCH FOR ALL STUDENTS

On August 31, the USDA approved the extension of the waiver allowing all students to eat lunch at no cost, regardless of eligibility status, through December 31, 2020. The district has been working to offer meals to all school age students and siblings under 18 who are residents of the PWSSD, whether a student is learning on campus, or via remote learning.

For Students attending school in our buildings

A free lunch will be available for students who choose to participate starting on Monday, September 14, 2020.

Lunch pick-up

Lunch pick-up will be available at **Thomas Jefferson Middle School** near the **kitchen door (north side of building; signage will identify proper location)**. Pick-up will take place on **WEDNESDAYS** between **10am and 1pm** for any family that is interested in meals for:

- 1 day if the student(s) attends school 4 days per week
- 3 days if the student(s) attends 2 days per week, or
- 5 days if the student(s) is/are attending virtually, attending a private school, or is a sibling (under 18) who does not attend school.

You will not need to preorder, however you will need to provide the following information at pick-up:

- Recipient's name and school
- The number of days of lunch that the student(s) qualify for (this may be different with multiple students in a household)

The first pick-up opportunity will be Wednesday, September 16th.

Extra cartons of milk will still be available at 40 cents each.
