Thank you for all the help and support of your children the last three months of school as we were required to do on-line instruction. There were several challenges, and you helped make it work for our students. Also, I know there are many questions about the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year, and several thoughts and ideas have been shared with us. Therefore, next week you will receive a survey from your principal to give us input about opening school in the fall. I encourage everyone to watch for the survey and complete it quickly so we will have accurate information from all our families. We will use the data from the survey to finalize our plans.
