Dear PWSSD Families,

We hope this letter finds everyone enjoying some summer fun with your family and friends. Before we know it, we will be starting the 2021-2022 school year, and we want you to be prepared for what this will look like in the Port Washington-Saukville School District. As more people have been vaccinated and the numbers of COVID-19 cases throughout Wisconsin continue to decline, we are planning for all students to return to school in-person for each scheduled school day. Synchronous on-line learning will not be a part of our instructional platform this upcoming school year. We feel it is important for our students and teachers to continue connecting and establishing those positive learning relationships we are known for in our District.

In addition, masks will remain optional for students and staff this fall. We encourage and support everyone in making their own family decisions regarding wearing a mask. Also, at this time we plan to continue contact-tracing positive COVID-19 cases, and continue following quarantine guidelines.

Quarantine is suggested but no longer required if:

- You are identified as a close contact to a positive individual, have worn a mask when in contact with this person, and you are symptom-free.
- You are identified as a close contact to a positive individual while participating in outdoor activities/sports with or without a mask, and you are symptom-free.
- You are identified as a close contact to a positive individual, are fully vaccinated, it has been 14 days since you received the second vaccination, and you are symptom-free.

Mandatory quarantine is still to be determined as we get closer to the school year and review the results of summer school

As always, we will monitor the data regarding the spread of COVID-19, including the new strains of the virus that are becoming more known across our country. We will then use these data to make adjustments to our safety protocols if necessary.

Our goal throughout this pandemic has been to provide the very best education possible while maintaining a safe learning environment for all our students. Working together, we will continue to meet and exceed this goal.
